

MEET THE AUTHOR PROGRAMME

05TH DECEMBER'2022

The department of English, Nar Bahadur Bhandari Government College, Tadong, had organized a “Meet the Author” programme on the 05th of December, 2022, from 01pm to 05pm, at the Seminar Hall of the College.

It is pertinent to mention here that the “Meet the Author” event is organized annually by the English Department as a part of its “Best Practices” with a view to providing the students a platform to interact with the writers in a face-to-face manner and learn from them. Most of these writer’s works are also a part of their syllabi. Writers from the North Eastern region are mostly invited to this event although there have been occasions when authors from other parts of the country had also participated.

The programme, held on 05th December 2022, was organized in collaboration with the group, “Writers from the Hills” and also with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college. As many as twelve authors from the Eastern Himalayan Region had actively participated in this programme and there were another ten non-participating authors from the region whose books were also displayed along with the works of those who were present.

Dr. D. Purohit, Principal, NBBG College, was the Chief Guest of the event. The programme began with a Welcome Address, delivered by Dr. Pramila Chettri, Associate Professor and HoD, English. The Principal of the College had also addressed the galaxy of authors, faculties and students assembled at the Hall while also congratulating the Department of English for providing such a space to the students where they could listen to and learn about the experiences and expertise of the authors.

The twelve writers who had attended this programme were: Mr. Guru T. Ladakhi, Dr. Satyadeep Chettri, Mr. Pankaj Giri, Mr. Kishan Dahal, Ms. Eunice Nirja, Mr. Vikash Goyal, Ashwini Tamang, Ms. Yumita Rai, Ms Denmit Lepcha, Ms. Priyanka Joshi, Mrs. Punam Sharma and Mr. Sandup Rongkup.

The writers read abstracts from their books and also shared the stories about their journeys as authors. They also gave valuable tips to the students about the various nuances of publishing, writing and articulating effectively. The students were encouraged to develop their reading habit, overcome hesitation, develop the zeal to write and also to hone their skills in the art of writing and expressing oneself.

Besides the presentations made by the writers, the programme also witnessed an open-mic session wherein the budding poets and writers from amongst the students recited and read out their self-composed poems and abstracts.

There was a lively interactive session at the end of the programme in which the queries about writing and publishing were addressed by the writers. The books published by the authors were also displayed and there was also a book-signing session at the end.

The event witnessed the participation of a large number of students from the English Department and there were students from the Reader's Association as well as from other departments of the college too. Faculties, both from the college and outside, had also attended.


